One Billion Literates Foundation (OBLF) (website)

Mission: OBLF is dedicated to transforming the lives of rural communities through a systemic focus on primary education, public health, developing socio-economic capacity for women, and rehabilitating the severely poor
Founding year: 2010

Focus Areas: Education, Women's Empowerment, Healthcare, Slum Rehabilitation

Impact: 43,000+ children, 350 rural women, and 15,000+ other adults

Founder's story: OBLF was co-founded by Anamika Majumder and Anish Ramachandra, to improve students' education. Anish Ramachandran left his job at Intel and became CEO in 2020. Under his leadership, OBLF has expanded its mission by creating an ecosystem of programs in education, women's empowerment, healthcare, and slum rehabilitation to improve the lives of the most vulnerable segments of 227 villages in the Anekal Taluk community outside Bangalore.

Partnership with Jupiter 360 is over 3 years to build a brand, infrastructure and deepen outreach to cover all 227 villages in Anekal District towards education, healthcare, adult literacy and jobs.



17,000 feet Foundation (website)

Mission: To improve education in the remotest and toughest Indian Himalayan Region (IHR) villages.

Founding year: 2011

Focus Areas: Education, Sustainable Communities

Impact: 50,000+ children, 900+ schools in Ladakh

Founder's story: After a solo trek in Ladakh when she experienced high-altitude pulmonary edema and had to recover at a remote village, Sujata Sahu witnessed the living conditions of local school children. Inspired to create change, she founded the 17000ft Foundation, delivering digital learning materials, establishing schools, libraries and playgrounds at 17,000 feet elevations.

Partnership with Jupiter 360 is over 3 years to build a brand, infrastructure and scale to 5 States in 5 years.

Mission: To enable the innovators of tomorrow to achieve their dreams by bringing science, technology, and learning to their doorstep today

Founding year: 2015

Focus Areas: Higher Education, Women's Empowerment, Science, Technology

Impact: 900 students, trained 100 Ph.D. students in STEMM education

Founder's story: A first generation learner from a remote village in the foothills of the Himalayas, Darshana's learning began with primary education at a municipal school in Delhi to graduating from Cambridge University with a doctorate in Physics. Darshana Joshi, is a role model for science students who dream big. She co-founded Vigyan Shaala in 2015 to mentor and coach girl students in STEMM disciplines and recalibrate the gender balance in the field.

Advisory role: To graduate 10,000 girls into STEMM based education and jobs by December 2023.

Founder's story: Deeply impacted by the difficult living conditions of the poorest people in rural India, Ved Arya decided to use his education and skills from MIT, Harvard, and the World Bank. Ved founded SRIJAN and Buddha Fellows encompassing two-decades of work engaged in poverty eradication and sustainable livelihood opportunities.

Advisory role: Create 5,000 entrepreneurs in 5,000 villages. Introduce the concept of a CEO for every village by partnering with local gram panchayats and community leaders
